## EUROPE: CONSEQUENCE

- **United Kingdom** – Ambassador removed. Chief of Staff resigns.
- **Slovakia** – National Security Adviser resigns after emails surface.
- **France** – Former minister resigns; investigation begins.
- **Norway** – Resignations, criminal investigation, corruption charges.

## UNITED STATES: DISTANCING

- Senior law firm chairman steps down.
- Top corporate lawyer exits.
- Cultural institution figure resigns.

## SWEDEN & UAE: REPLACEMENT

- Humanitarian leader resigns after disclosure.
  - Global logistics CEO replaced after revelations.

## INDIA: SILENCE

**Union Minister, Petroleum & Natural Gas** — No resignation. No dismissal. No public inquiry. Continues in Cabinet.

Across democracies and corporations, association triggered exit. In India, association triggered nothing.

The contrast is not legal. It is political. It is about thresholds of public shame, standards of ministerial responsibility, and the elasticity of accountability.
