CLAIM: "Exchanged just one email"

EMAIL RECORD: At least 8–10 separate exchanges over three years (2014–2017).

CLAIM: "One substantive email and one or two others"

EMAIL RECORD: Multiple substantive exchanges: Digital India pitch, visa facilitation, meeting requests, praise of 'taste in people'.

CLAIM: "Met as part of a delegation"

EMAIL RECORD: Emails show one-on-one meetings — 'I will be there by 11 am', 'want to drop by for a chat'.

CLAIM: "I didn't seek meetings"

EMAIL RECORD: Meeting requests initiated in Dec 2014, Jan 2017, May 2017, and June 2017.

CLAIM: "Had nothing to do with his island"

EMAIL RECORD: Reference to 'your exotic island' and encouragement to 'have fun'.

CLAIM: "Three-four references out of three million emails"

EMAIL RECORD: Sustained correspondence June 2014–June 2017 with confirmed meetings.

CLAIM: Shared only "personal analysis" on Digital India

EMAIL RECORD: Detailed policy material shared 8 months before official launch (1 July 2015).

CLAIM: "Interactions were to promote India"

EMAIL RECORD: 'You, my friend, make things happen. Any advice?' — seeking strategic direction.
